Definitions:

- **Wisdom:** (Amplified) “comprehensive insight into the ways and purposes of God.” (Proverbs 4:11)
- **Fools:** They despise the wisdom of God and His instructions. (Proverbs 1:7); (Proverbs 1:22)
- **Simple:** A person who does not know much. This person is naïve and can be easily influenced. Proverbs 1:4
- **Scorner/mockerscoffer:** “In scripture, is one who scoffs at religion, its ordinances and teachers, and who makes a mock of sin and the judgments and threatenings of God against sinners.” (Noah Webster’s 1828 Dictionary) (Proverbs 1:22)
- **Discretion:** Prudence, or knowledge and prudence; that discernment which enables a person to judge critically of what is correct and proper, united with caution; (Proverbs 2:11)
- **Knowledge:** Is referring to the knowledge of God. God has perfect knowledge of all His works. (Proverbs 2:10,)
- **Knowledge and Understanding:** Refers to having the understanding of how to apply the knowledge or the wisdom of God in your life. (Proverbs 2:2,3,5,10)
- **Wicked:** Evil in principle or practice; deviating from the divine law; In Scripture, persons who live in sin; transgressors of the divine law; all who are un-reconciled to God, unsanctified or impenitent. (Proverbs 2:22)
